*“1. That he shall furnish a cash surety of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) alongwith a personal bond in the like amount for his release on Furlough to the satisfaction of the Superintendent, Central Jail No.14, Mandoli”*

6. Needless to say rest of the conditions as contained in the order dated 21.06.2024 passed by the Jail Superintendant shall remain same.
7. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and is disposed of in the above terms.
8. The date of 24.04.2025 stands cancelled.
