1. Mr. Parveen Tyagi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, states that present petition under Section 29 of DV Act is not maintainable before this Court and, therefore, seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition i.e. CRL.M.C. 1245/2024, with liberty to file an appropriate petition.
