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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeks the following prayer-

(a) Direct to the respondent No.1 to issue recovery certificate in terms of applications dated 28.02.2013, 11.04.2013, 18.04.2013, 23.04.2013 and 04.02.2014 and give it to the Collector/ Respondent No.2 for recovery of arrears of land revenue as per law under Section 33(C)(1) of the Industrial Disputes Act;

(b) Direct the respondent No.1 to pay the legal fee of Rs. 1,00,000/- towards the unnecessary litigation and for defending the case

(c) Direct the respondent No.1 to pay Rs. 5,000/- each to the petitioners herein for mental agony and harassment caused to the petitioners.

(d) Pass any other order that is deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case

3. Learned counsel for respondent no.2, on the instructions of Assistant



Collector-GR-I, SDM, Karol Bagh, submits that the recovery certificate issued by the Deputy Labour Commissioner, Central District, Employment Exchange Building, Pusa Campus, Delhi have been received from the State Bank of India and handed over to Deputy Labour Commissioner, Central District. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid position.

4. In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
5. Leave granted.
6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.
