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1. The present Appeal has been filed under Section 10 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966 read with Order XLIII Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 assailing the Judgment/Order dated 21.12.2022 passed by the learned Single Judge in TEST.CAS 79/2015 captioned ***Dharam Vir vs. State.***
