1. The learned APP for the State submits that out of the four eye-witnesses, two eye-witnesses have been completely examined, one of the eye-witnesses has been partly cross-examined and remaining 01 eye-witness is yet to be examined.
2. The learned APP submits that the next date of hearing before the learned Trial Court is 21.07.2025, for further cross-examination of the third eye witness.
3. The learned APP submits that possibly the examination of the eye-witnesses would be completed within two months.
4. In view of the above submission of the learned APP, the learned



counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present bail application, with liberty to file afresh when all the eye-witnesses would be examined by the prosecution before the learned trial court.

5. Permission and liberty, as prayed for, in accordance with law, is granted.

6. The bail application is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.
