2. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the CrPC seeks the following prayers: -

Allow the present petition and may direct / order for deleting the names of the petitioners namely Parikshit Sharma (father-in-law), Vandana Sharma (mother-in-law) and Dr. Shweta Sharma (sister-in-law) from the array of accused persons in respect of the F.I.R.
