Vide Order dated 22.12.2022, Hon'ble Delhi Court has directed CARA that "Irrespective of whether the DM's verification, is received or not, in the unique facts of this case, which predates the coming into force of the Regulations, the NOC shall now be processed and issued by Respondent to the Petitioners within a period of 30 days from today, subject to availability of all documents on the record of CARA."

CARA earlier issued Adoption Support Letter on 16.1.2023 as per Adoption Regulations 2022 and as per procedure laid down for inter country adoption for children adopted under the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956, by parents who desire to relocate the child.

NOC is issued after receiving Articles from the receiving country, i.e. Home study(Article 15) and permission of the receiving country(Article 5). In the instant case, however, Support Letter was issued in the absence of required Articles.

The Support letter, therefore, issued by CARA on 16.1.2023 may be treated as No Objection from CARA as per direction issued by Hon'ble Delhi Court vide its order dtd.22.12.2022 (copy enclosed).
