I.A. 31128/2025 (joint application by the parties for recording settlement)

1. The parties jointly filed the instant application, and they submit that they have settled their grievance by way of the Settlement Agreement dated 18.11.2025 before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre.
2. Order XXIII, Rule 3 of the CPC authorises the Court to pass a decree on a compromise wherein the parties to the dispute have made an arrangement to settle the dispute. It has been comprehensively stated in the provision that the settlement arrived at should meet the essentials laid down therein, namely, (i) the compromise is lawful (ii) it is reduced in writing, and (iii) it is duly signed by the parties arriving at the compromise.



3. The settlement has been agreed upon without fear or coercion and the parties appear to have entered into the settlement agreement on their own volition.
4. The Court is satisfied that the settlement has arrived between the parties following due procedure and meeting the essentials specified in Order XXIII, Rule 3. Therefore, the parties shall be bound by the aforesaid settlement agreement.
5. In view of the aforesaid, the civil suit stands decreed in terms of the settlement agreement.
6. Application stands disposed of.

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1. In view of the order passed in I.A. 31128/2025, the Registry is directed to draw-up a decree sheet.
2. The civil suit stands disposed of.
3. The Settlement Agreement shall form part of the decree.
4. The next date fixed i.e., 26.02.2026 stands cancelled.
