1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of the present petition, seeking the limited relief that his Statutory Petition under Section 117(2) of the Border Security Act, 1968 against the order dated 12.04.2024 convicting him with punishment of dismissal from service, be decided by the Competent Authority expeditiously.
