The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2024 (BNSS)/Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) seeking a stay of the operation of the two Execution Petition bearing nos.21461/2024 and 21471/2024, both titled as “**Abhilasha Chauhan vs. Ankur Rajput**” pending before learned Mahila Court-02, South West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi till the final disposal of the Appeal No.2262/2024 before the learned ASJ(FTC), South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi.
