Pass necessary directions and orders thereby setting aside and quashing of the impugned FIR bearing no. 0331/2022 dated 20.08.2022 under sections 498-A/406/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at PS: Vasant Kunj North (New Delhi district) at behest of Respondent No. 2/Complainant and all the proceedings emanating therefrom.
