1. These petitions have been filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('A&C Act') seeking extension of the arbitral proceedings which are underway before the Sole Arbitrator.



2. The proceedings have been extended twice earlier and shall be expiring on 28th February 2025.
3. Counsel for respondent consents to 6 months' extension, whereas counsel for petitioner, however, pleads extension for a period of one year, considering the nature of dispute which involves certain complex questions.
