3. By way of the present petition, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks modification of order dated 09.01.2025 passed in Criminal Appeal No. 02/2025, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge (ASJ), New Delhi, Patiala House Court, whereby the application filed by the petitioner/accused under Section 430(3) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereafter 'BNSS') in a pending appeal against his conviction under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, was allowed on the ground of depositing 20% of the fine /compensation.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the financial



condition of the petitioner herein is as such that he is not able to deposit 20% of the fine/compensation amount imposed by the learned ASJ *vide* order dated 09.01.2025.

5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 09.01.2025 is modified to that extent that petitioner is allowed to deposit 15% of the fine/compensation amount instead of 20% as imposed vide order dated 09.01.2025.

6. In view of the above, the present petition along with pending application stands disposed of.
