An application under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 ('BNSS') has been preferred on behalf of petitioner for grant of transit anticipatory bail and interim protection from coercive action of the Police, against criminal complaint(s) filed by respondent no. 3 in FIR No. unknown emanating from order S. No. 3582 dated 28.10.2024, PS: Beta 2, Greater Noida, Distt. Gautam Buddha Nagar, Uttar Pradesh - 201310.
2. Learned APP for the State appears on advance notice.
