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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Section 482 of the CrPC seeks the following prayers: -

“A. Quash the entire criminal complaint being complaint case No. 2937/2019 of section 138 NI Act, before Ms. Ms. Aishwarya Kashyap, Ld. MM karkardooma courts, Delhi as well as the summoning order dated 26.09.2019 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom may kindly be quashed, in the interest of justice.

B. Stay the proceedings of the complaint case No. 2937/2019 of section 138 NI Act, before Ms. Aishwarya Kashyap, Ld. MM karkardooma courts, Delhi during the pendency of the present petition, in the interest of justice.

C. Pass any such order(s) may be passed that this Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper for the adjudication of the present petition.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the impugned complaint has been dismissed in default for non-prosecution by the learned Trial Court *vide* order dated 11.06.2025.



4. In view of the above learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings in accordance with law in case the aforesaid complaint is restored.
5. Leave and liberty granted.
6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.
7. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
