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1. After hearing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, does not press the present petition.

He, however, submits that since the learned Arbitral Tribunal has given indulgence to claimant of filing additional documents and leading evidence when the matter was already fixed for final arguments, he may also be given an opportunity in this regard. In view of the above, the petitioner herein is given liberty to move appropriate application in this regard, after the documents are placed on record by the claimant and after the witnesses are examined by the claimant and the learned Arbitral Tribunal would consider the abovesaid application, in accordance with law.
5. The petition stands disposed of as not pressed.
6. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
7. All rights and contentions of the parties are left open.
