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1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with the liberty to institute proceedings before a Court of competent civil jurisdiction for redressal of the grievances of the petitioner.
3. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the



liberty to the petitioner to take recourse of any other legal remedy, which may be available to him, including institution of a suit with appropriate prayers before a Court of competent civil jurisdiction. In case, any such suit along with an application for grant of interim injunction etc. is moved, the same shall be considered and decided with due expedition by the Court/Forum concerned.
