3. By way of the present petition, the petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR bearing no. 0357/2021, registered at Police Station Fatehpur Beri, New Delhi, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 498A/308/341/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereafter 'IPC') and emanating proceedings arising therefrom.
4. Issue notice. Mr. Shoaib Haider, learned APP accepts notice on behalf

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of the State.

5. Brief facts of the case are that the marriage between the petitioner no. 1 and the respondent no. 2 was solemnized at Delhi on 07.12.2014, in accordance with Hindu rites. The marriage between the petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2 was consummated and three children were born out of the said wedlock. It is stated that due to various differences, disputes and issues had arisen between the petitioners and the respondent no. 2. Upon the complaint by respondent no. 2, the present FIR came to be registered against the petitioners. It is stated that with intervention of the family and friends, the parties have now amicably settled their dispute at Mediation Centre, Saket Court, Delhi dated 23.11.2021, and their statements to the said effect have been recorded by the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial) on 19.03.2025.

6. All the petitioners and respondent no. 2 are present before this Court and have been identified by their learned counsels and Investigating Officer (IO) concerned, Police Station, Fatehpur Beri, Delhi.

7. On a query made by this Court, respondent no. 2 who has been identified by the IO, has categorically stated that she has entered into compromise out of her own free will and without any pressure, coercion or threat. It is also stated that they have been living together since 23.11.2021. Therefore, she has no objection if the FIR is quashed.

8. In view of the above, that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, and without any coercion, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them. It would thus be in interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

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9. Accordingly, FIR bearing no. 0357/2021, registered at Police Station Fatehpur Beri, New Delhi, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 498A/308/341/34 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

10. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
