1. The petitioner/Association is seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for the alleged wilful defiance and non-compliance of the directions contained in the orders dated 19.09.2024 in W.P.(C) No. 11189/2024 and 21.08.2024 in W.P.(C) NO. 11537/2024, passed by this Court.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents is present on advance notice.



3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents present through VC that the directions of this Court have since been complied with and the representation of the petitioner has since been decided.
