3. The present petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:-

“(a) this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to quash the complaint and other proceedings held and orders passed against the petitioner in Case No. SC/225/17 titled "NCB Vs. Ikechukwu Chukwubikem Stanley & Ors.” U/s 21, 23 and 29 of NDPS Act, in the interest of justice.

(b) pass any other/further order(s) in favour of the petitioner as deemed fit and proper by this Hon'ble Court in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to



withdraw the present petition seeking directions for the expeditious completion of trial.
