- a. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing Respondents to issue recovery certificate in the pending Applications under Section 33C(1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Annexure P-2) as per procedure expeditiously without any delay; and
- b. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing the Respondent no. 2 to adhere to the Guidelines laid down by Notification dated 05.07.2019 in its true letter and spirit; and
- c. Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing the Respondent No. 1 to review the pendency of Applications under Section 33C(1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 and to oversee



the compliance of Notification dated 05.07.2019 and upload the report on the website of the Labour Department on a monthly basis; and/or]

d. Pass any such other or further order as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and appropriate in the facts and circumstances of the case in favour of the Petitioners.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
4. Leave granted.
5. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
6. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
