1. This application has been filed under Order XXIII Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking the recording of compromise arrived at between the parties. The Application is duly supported by affidavits of the authorised representative of the plaintiffs and of the defendant.
2. It is stated that the parties have settled their disputes in the mediation proceedings conducted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Nath, Former Judge of this Court.
3. The parties have entered into a Settlement Agreement dated 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2025, which has been duly signed by the authorised representatives of the parties. The terms of the agreement are stated to be confidential in nature.
