3. The application is disposed of.

4. This is a petition filed under section 29 A (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period of 2 months.
5. The mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal expired on 11.03.2025.
6. Mr. Marwah, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the delay in concluding the arbitral proceedings is due to the voluminous records pertaining to the matter.
7. For the said reasons, issue notice. Mr. Nagarkatti, learned counsel for



the respondent accepts notice and has no objection to the present petition being allowed.
