1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application shall stand disposed of.

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3. The petitioner is constrained to approach this Court consequent to a failure on the part of the respondents to conclude the Show Cause Notice ["SCN"] proceedings which commenced pursuant to the issuance of that notice on 25 February 2025. The Goods and Services Tax ["GST"] registration of the petitioner has also come to be placed in suspension in terms of that notice.



4. In view of the aforesaid, we find no justification to retain the writ petition in our board. The same shall consequently stand disposed of with a direction to the concerned respondent to ensure that the SCN proceedings are concluded with due expedition and preferably within a period of four weeks from today.

5. The respondent shall proceed in the matter in accordance with law and after providing an opportunity of hearing to the writ petitioner.

6. All rights and contentions of respective parties on merits are kept open.
