1. Criminal Miscellaneous Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*hereinafter referred to as 'Cr.P.C.'*) has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, Mr. Sandeep Kumar against the Order dated 17.02.2021 *vide* which the learned Metropolitan Magistrate had directed the registration of the FIR No. 76/2022 dated 26.01.2022 under Section 304 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Karawal Nagar and which has been upheld by the learned ASJ *vide* Order dated 18.03.2021.
