**ORDER**

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**17.11.2025**

1. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, submits that while arguing the matter it is revealed that challenge to decision dated 05.04.2022 is necessitated being against the statutory provision.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file fresh. However, the prayer is that the interim protection granted during the pendency of this petition be continued for three weeks from today.
3. In view of the limited prayer made, learned counsel for the respondents is not in a position to raise a serious objection, submission is that liberty be granted to the respondents to proceed against the petitioner



for disciplinary/department proceedings if so necessitated.

4. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. All pending applications stand dismissed.

5. It is clarified that the interim protection shall not act as an impediment for respondents for initiating other proceedings against the petitioners.
