I.A. 27700/2025 (filed on behalf of plaintiff and defendant No.1 under Order XXIII Rule 3 r/w Section 151 CPC)

1. Learned counsel appearing for the parties jointly submit that they have amicably resolved their dispute as per the terms recorded in paragraph No.2 of the application.

2. Order XXIII, Rule 3 authorises the Court to pass a decree on a compromise wherein, the parties to the dispute have made an arrangement to settle the dispute. It has been comprehensively stated in the provision that the settlement arrived at should meet the essentials laid down therein, namely, (i) the compromise is lawful (ii) it is reduced in writing (iii) it is duly signed by the parties arriving at the compromise.



3. The settlement has been agreed upon without fear or coercion and the parties appear to have entered into the settlement agreement on their own volition.
4. The Court is satisfied that the settlement has been arrived at between the parties following due procedure and meeting the essentials specified Order XXIII, Rule 3. Therefore, the parties shall be bound by the aforesaid settlement agreement.
5. Suit stands decreed in terms of the application.
6. Let this application to form part of the decree.
7. Application stands disposed of.

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1. In view of the order passed in I.A. 27700/2025, the suit is disposed of.
2. The date already fixed in the matter, i.e., 21.01.2026, stands cancelled.
