He additionally submits that the phone number of the concerned beat officer will be provided to the petitioners and they are at liberty to call the beat officer in case they apprehend threat to their life and liberty.

7. He, however, submits that no action can be taken at this stage in case the family members of Petitioner no.1 make a call and speak to their daughter.

8. In view above, no further orders are required to be passed at this stage. Petitioners are at liberty to approach appropriate forum in case of any grievance remains in the future.
