3. The present petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeks the following prayers: -

“a) Quash the FIR bearing no. 0168/2022, registered at PS- Pul Prahladpur, Delhi u / s 498A & 406 IPC qua the Petitioners, the final report u/s 173, CrPC 1983, and the consequential trial taking place in Cr. Case No. 9785 of 2023, pending before the Court of Ms. Anam Rais Khan, Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class (Mahila Court - 01), District - South East, Saket Courts; and b) pass such other and further order(s) that this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take the grounds taken herein before the learned Trial Court at the time of consideration on point of charge.
5. Leave and liberty granted.
6. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.
7. Pending application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
8. It is made clear that no arguments on merits have taken place.
9. Needless to state that the learned Trial Court shall decide the same on the merits of the present case in accordance with law.
