1. Further to the order dated 26.03.2025, Ms. Aliza Alam and Ms. Laavanya Kaushik, learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submit that the petitioner will be permitted to participate in the Lower Division Clerk ["LDC"] Examination for the post of Assistant Account Officer.
