Mukherjee Nagar pending before the court of Ms. Amardeep Kaur, Hon'ble CMM, North District, Rohini Court, New Delhi within a time-bound period as deemed fit by this Hon'ble Court;

b. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction to the respondent authorities to ensure that no unnecessary adjournments or delays occur in the trial, and that the prosecution produces its witnesses



without delay;

c. Pass such further order as may be deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice.”
