CRL.M.C. 2096/2025

1. Criminal Petition under Section 528 BNSS has been filed for quashing of FIR No.137/2015 under Section 498A/406/34 IPC and Section 4 of The Dowry Prohibition Act, P.S.Harsh Nagar in view of the Settlement dated 27.03.2018.
2. The statement of the parties have already been recorded by the learned J.R.
3. In terms of the Settlement, Respondent No.2 who is present in person endorses the terms of the Settlement and also submits that the



divorce has already been granted by mutual consent *vide* Decree dated 27.11.2018. An amount of ₹2.5 lakhs for the past, present and future alimony has also been received by her.

4. In view of the Settlement which is endorsed by the parties, the FIR No.137/2015 under Section 498A/406/34 IPC and 4 of The Dowry Prohibition Act, P.S.Harsh Nagar and consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed. The parties shall remain bound by the terms of the Settlement.
