1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The applicant(s) shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A (4) & (5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of 6 months.
5. It is stated that the matter is at the final stage of arguments and thereafter the award needs to be pronounced.
6. Issue notice.
7. Mr. Singh, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and has no objection to the petition being allowed.
8. Since the arbitration proceedings are at the final stage of argument,
