C. HARI SHANKAR, J.

1. Mr. Bhuvneshwar Tyagi, learned Counsel for the appellant, submits that he is agreeable to a disposal of this appeal with the direction that the goods which were seized from his premises would continue to remain under *superdari* with him pending disposal of the suit before the learned Commercial Court.
