1. Mr. Roshal Lal Saini, learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions from the appellant, who is present in Court and duly identified by the I.O states that the appellant has already undergone the entire sentence and having understood the consequences, he does not wish to press the appeal on merits.
2. He submits that the fine has already been paid.
