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1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a limited relief *viz.* that the appeal preferred by the petitioner under Rule 22(3)(4) of the Delhi Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Rules, 2009, against the order dated 25.08.2023 passed by the District Magistrate/Deputy Collector in Case No.126 of 2022 be decided expeditiously.
