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1. This writ petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a direction to Respondent No.1/School not to disturb their studies and allow them to continue in the School without any disturbance as also for arranging extra classes for the examination.

2. Mr. Abhinav Sharma, learned counsel appearing for Respondent No. 2/Directorate of Education (DoE), GNCTD hands over a copy of the communication dated 02.12.2025 received from Respondent No. 1/School, wherein the status of the Petitioners has been detailed in a tabular form, which is extracted hereunder for the ease of reference:-

5. Order sheets indicate that Petitioners have been unrepresented for the last three dates of hearing. None appears for the Petitioners even today despite the fact that matter was kept at a short date.

6. In view of above, no further order is required to be passed in the writ petition, which is accordingly disposed of along with the pending application.
