W.P.(C) 4736/2025

1. The petitioners are employees in the respondent No. 2-Bureau of Indian Standard ["BIS"]. They have filed a representation on 27.01.2025, seeking an opportunity to participate in the Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for the post of Scientific Cadre or, in the alternative, to reserve/earmark the post of Scientific Cadre for Technical Assistant(Lab).

2. The only relief sought is for the disposal of their representation



within a fixed time frame.

3. Mr. Varun Singh, learned counsel for respondent No. 2, who appears on advance notice, submits, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the respondents on the merits of the petitioners' grievance, that the representation will be disposed of by BIS within a period of eight weeks from today.

4. Noting the aforesaid submission, the writ petition is disposed of.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not commented upon the merits of the matter.
