The present Criminal Revision petition under Section 438 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, (BNSS) is filed by the petitioner assailing the Judgment /Order dated 15.01.2025 (Impugned Judgment) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-03, (South East), Saket Courts, New Delhi (Trial Court) in Crl. Appeal No. 63/2023, titled "*Manisha Kumari Vs. Vikas Kumar*" and Crl.



Appeal No. 101/2023 titled "***Vikas Kumar Vs Manisha Kumari***" whereby the learned Trial Court has set aside the interim Order of maintenance passed under Section 23 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005.
