1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff in terms of the observations made by this Court on 04.03.2025 and on instructions, seeks liberty to withdraw the instant civil suit with a further liberty to file another properly constituted civil suit.



2. In the interest of justice and without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties, the Court deems it appropriate to permit the plaintiff to withdraw the instant civil suit with a liberty to file another properly constituted civil suit.
