“a. quash the impugned order dated 16.04.2021 passed by the Learned Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (Special Acts) Central District, Delhi in Complaint bearing Ct. Case No.1422/2021 dated 23.02.2021 titled as "Income Tax Office Vs. SVS Buildcon Pvt. Ltd. & Anr." filed by Respondent No.2 under Section 276B and 279(1) read with section 278E, 179(1) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 for the Financial Year: 2012-13, Assessment Year: 2013-14 as well as all further proceedings emanating therefrom against the petitioner and quash the said complaint against the petitioner.

b. pass such other/further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in favour of the Petitioner and against the Respondent No.2, in the interest of justice.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the

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petitioner has been discharged by the learned Trial Court *vide* order 18.03.2025. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.2 confirms the same.

4. In view of the above, he seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
5. Leave granted.
6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
