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1. It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.2 has already filed an affidavit on 16.09.2025.
2. In the said affidavit, respondent No.2 has stated that he is giving up/forgoing all his claims in respect of his employment with DTC/petitioner in the present case and he undertakes that he will not file/claim any other reliefs with respect to his employment with DTC.
