1. This application has been filed by the petitioner for early hearing.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, and with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the application is allowed and the writ petition is taken up for hearing.

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3. Further to the order dated 02.04.2025, Ms. Diya Kapur, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, seeks to withdraw this writ petition, with liberty to agitate the petitioner's grievances before the Central Administrative Tribunal ["Tribunal"].
4. Ms. Kapur submits that the petitioner may be permitted to raise all applicable grounds, including under the Rights of Persons with

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Disabilities Act, 2016 before the Tribunal.

5. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.

6. Mr. Kapur requests for expedition of the case before the Tribunal on the ground that the case concerns a person with disability. The petitioner is at liberty to seek an expeditious hearing before the Tribunal.
