1. Petitioner is plaintiff before the learned Trial Court and has filed a suit seeking recovery. It is aggrieved by order dated 06.12.2023 whereby unconditional leave to defend has been granted to its adversary.
2. The next date in the present matter is 23.09.2025 and the present application has been moved seeking early hearing.
