1. The present petition is directed against order dated 14th November, 2018, wherein the Petitioner was charged for the offences under Sections 376(2)(n)/377/342/323/328/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
2. However, during the pendency of the present proceedings, the trial stood concluded and by order dated 28th August, 2024, the Petitioner has been acquitted.
