2. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the BNSS seeks the following prayers:

“(a) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of *Certiorari* declaring the action of the respondent in putting the name of the petitioner in the List of Bad Character as illegal;
(b) issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the name of mandamus directing the respondent to remove the name of the petitioner from the list of Bad Characters maintained in Register No.10, Part-II and Bundle-A (Surveillance Register);
(c) Pass such other or further order(s) as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit in the interest of justice.”

3. Learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State, on advance notice submits that the representation dated 10.02.2025 on behalf of the petitioner is under consideration and the decision on the same shall be intimated to the



petitioner within a period of four weeks. Let the same be done.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings in accordance with law, if so required.

5. Leave and liberty granted.

6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
