ORDER

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1. This petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 03rd April 2025 passed in **W.P. (C) NO.4208/2025**, where the directions in question are extracted as under:

2. Given the innocuous nature of the prayer sought, the respondent is directed to schedule a hearing in respect of the complaint filed by the petitioner and dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible.

3. The learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner also submits that since the petitioner is illiterate and incapable of defending himself during the course of hearing before the respondent, the counsel of the petitioner may be allowed to represent the petitioner before the respondent/ Commission.

4. The respondent/ Commission is requested to consider allowing an authorised representative/ counsel to represent the petitioner during hearing/s of the aforesaid complaint.

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2. Counsel for *National Commission for Schedule Castes (respondent)* appears on advance Notice and states as per his instructions, a communication of the order was received and the process is underway.
3. Counsel for respondent states that the matter is scheduled and is going to be fixed within two weeks. Petitioner will be duly informed of the fixture of the scheduled date.
4. If petitioner wishes to appear, he is at liberty to appear before the *National Commission* in this regard.
5. Complaint shall be disposed of within a week after the scheduled date of the proceeding.
6. Accordingly, basis this undertaking/directions, the said petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to revive the petition, in case of any residual issues.
7. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
