Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*hereinafter referred to as 'Cr.PC'*) (Section 528 of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023*) (*hereinafter referred to as 'B.N.S.S.'*) has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner, Rakesh Kumar for quashing of E-FIR No. 447/2019 dated 09.04.2019 under Section 392/394/397/411/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*hereinafter referred to as 'IPC'*) registered at Police



Station Bhajanpura, Delhi and all the consequential proceedings emanating therefrom, in terms of the Settlement Deed dated 15.04.2025.

4. Issue Notice.

5. On advance Notice, learned APP has appeared and accepted the Notice on behalf of the State.

6. The allegations in the FIR are that at about 12 midnight, the Complainant was stopped by two persons, who were on motorcycle, who gave him injury with a knife on his stomach and also snatched his purse and mobile. The Respondent No. 2 identified the motorcycle and the Petitioner about two days later and thereafter, the Petitioner was arrested. After investigation, the Charge-Sheet has been filed.

7. On the Complaint of the Respondent No.2/Complainant, E-FIR No.447/2019 dated 09.04.2019 under Section 392/394/397/411/34 of IPC, got registered at Police Station Bhajanpura, Delhi.

8. Learned counsel for the Petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the Petition.

9. The Petition is permitted to be withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
