1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeks the following prayers: -

“a) Initiate Contempt Proceedings against the Respondent for his wilful violation of order dated 10.4.2023 in Writ Petition NO. 4435/2006 titled as "DR. V.S. LUV VS DELHI BHARTIYA CHIKTSA PARISHAD" and punish the Respondent in and accordance with the law under sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971;

b) Call for the personal appearance of Contemnor/ Respondent to explain the blatant contempt of the order dated 10.4.2023.

c) Direct the respondent/contemnor to comply with order dated 10.4.2023 passed by this Hon 'ble court in Writ Petition NO. 4435/2006 titled as "DR. V.S. LUV VS DELHI BHARTIYA CHIKTSA PARISHAD"



Pass any other appropriate order / direction which this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the respondent has complied with the directions passed in order dated 10.04.2023 passed in W.P.(C) 4435/2006 and in view of the same, he seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
4. The present is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.
