1. Though the Judgment in this appeal had been reserved, we are happy to note that the appellant and the respondent no.1, who is the only contesting respondent/plaintiff in the suit, have amicably settled their disputes, placing on record a Memorandum of Settlement ('MoU') dated 26.05.2025.
2. In terms of the said MoU, the respondent no.1 has received the amount of Rs.26 lacs from the appellant in full and final satisfaction of the decretal amount.
3. The respondent no.1 shall also remain bound by the statements given in the MoU.
4. The application is accordingly allowed. The decree is declared to have been satisfied in the above terms.



5. The appeal is disposed of.
6. As the appeal had been heard on the first date itself and the Judgment had been reserved, whereafter the parties have amicably settled their disputes, the appellant is held entitled to a refund of the Court fee.
7. Let a certificate of refund be accordingly prepared and handed over to the learned counsel for the appellant.
